This matter having been remanded by the North Carolina Court of Appeals in a decision issued on 18 March 2014 following the issuance on 12 March 2012 of an Order granting summary judgment to Defendants, the undersigned, exercising the Court's inherent authority and discretion to manage this case and having scheduled a status conference on 4 April 2014 during which counsel for the parties were present, and upon the arguments of counsel, makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On 25 January 2007, the undersigned issued an Order Allowing Preliminary Injunction staying the executions of Plaintiffs Marcus Robinson and James Edward Thomas. Similar injunctions were issued by the undersigned for Plaintiff James A. Campbell on 29 January 2007 and Plaintiff Archie Lee Billings on 22 February 2007.
- 2. On 6 March 2007, in the case of *State v. Holman*, 97 CRS 49226 (Wake County Superior Court), the undersigned issued an Order to Cancel Execution Date for death row inmate Allen Holman and directed that Holman's execution "shall not be re-scheduled until all requirements of the execution protocol and of the law can be met."
- 3. On 24 October 2013, during the pendency of the Plaintiffs' appeal of the Order granting summary judgment, Defendant Frank L. Perry, Secretary of the North Carolina Department of Public Safety, approved a new, one-drug lethal injection execution protocol.
- 4. On 31 March 2014, the Office of the Attorney General of North Carolina delivered three (3) letters to Defendant Perry notifying him that, pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 15-194,

the conditions precedent had been satisfied to require the scheduling of executions for three inmates on death row at Central Prison: Holman, James Floyd Davis, and Phillip Wilkinson.

- 5. As the Senior Resident Judge of the Tenth Judicial District, the undersigned received a copy of the letter sent to Defendant Perry directing that the execution of Allen Holman be scheduled.
- 6. This Court has been directed by the North Carolina Court of Appeals to determine whether the new, one-drug lethal injection execution protocol must be promulgated through rulemaking under the North Carolina Administrative Procedure Act.
- 7. The one-drug lethal injection execution protocol approved by Defendant Perry has not been reviewed by the undersigned or the appellate courts to determine whether it comports with the Eighth Amendment requirement that cruel and unusual punishments shall not be inflicted and comports with the North Carolina Constitution's requirement that cruel or unusual punishments shall not be inflicted.

BASED ON THE FOREGOING FINDINGS OF FACT, THE UNDERSIGNED MAKES THE FOLLOWING

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Defendant Perry (or his successor as Secretary of Public Safety) and Defendant Joyner (or his successor as Warden of Central Prison) are enjoined from either scheduling or carrying out any execution, whether by lethal injection or any other means, until such time as this Court has determined whether the selected method of execution comports with the requirements of the federal and state constitutions and whether the one-drug protocol is subject to rulemaking under the North Carolina Administrative Procedure Act and all direct appellate review of those determinations has been completed.
 - 2. The undersigned retains jurisdiction over all matters in this case.

This matter is before the Court on review of the status of these proceedings. For the reasons set forth below, the Court finds it appropriate to enter an order temporarily staying this case until further notice.

- 1. This case began in January 2007 when Plaintiffs, who are all death-sentenced prisoners, filed complaints asserting constitutional and statutory challenges to the execution procedures in effect at that time.
- 2. Defendants sought summary judgment on Plaintiffs' claims, arguing they lacked any merit. On March 12, 2012, the Court entered summary judgment in Defendants' favor on all claims. Plaintiffs appealed.
- 3. During the pendency of the appeal, the General Assembly amended N.C. Gen. Stat. § 15-188, which provides for the manner and place of execution. The Secretary of the Department

of Public Safety subsequently replaced the prior execution protocol and adopted a new execution procedure manual.

- 4. On March 18, 2014, in *Robinson v. Shanahan*, COA13-504, the North Carolina Court of Appeals remanded the case for further consideration and development of the record as to the issues raised by the amendments to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 15-188 and the adoption of the new execution procedure.
- 5. On April 28, 2014, this Court entered an order enjoining Defendants from scheduling or carrying out any execution until such time as the Court determined whether North Carolina's method of execution, as provided in the new execution procedure, comported with the law and all appellate review of those determinations was completed. Plaintiffs subsequently filed a Petition for Review of Rule-Making Denial on July 21, 2014, and a Second Consolidated Amended Complaint on December 10, 2014.
- On January 12, 2015, Defendants filed a notice of removal to federal court. On June 25, 2015, the federal district court remanded the case back to this Court. See Robinson v. Perry, No. 5:15-CT-3008-D (E.D.N.C.).
- 7. Contemporaneously with these proceedings, and by federal court order, the parties have periodically provided status reports to federal district courts that are also considering challenges to the execution process. The parties have represented that they do not expect any execution dates to be set for Plaintiffs until after the resolution of litigation involving the now-repealed Racial Justice Act (RJA) and the conclusion of any pending litigation regarding lethal injection either in state court or federal court. *See, e.g., Blakeney v. Hooks*, No. 5:07-CT-3153-FL (E.D.N.C) (status report filed September 21, 2015). The parties most recently provided this information in status reports filed in September 2018. The federal district courts have held their cases in abeyance, in part, due to the ongoing RJA matters.

- 8. The Court finds in this regard that the Supreme Court of North Carolina is currently considering six cases raising issues under the RJA, and issues relating to the repeal of that enactment, and that these cases are fully briefed and awaiting designation of a date for oral argument. See State v. Augustine, No. 130A03-2, State v. Golphin, No. 441A98-4, Szate v. Robinson, No. 411A94-6, State v. Walters, No. 54800-2, State v. Ramseur, No. 388A10, State v. Burke, No. 181A93-4. Resolution of the issues in these cases may affect the ability of North Carolina death row prisoners, including Plaintiffs, to proceed on the merits of motions for appropriate relief involving allegations of racial bias in capital jury selection, charging, and sentencing as raised pursuant to the now-repealed RJA. See also N.C. Gen. Stat. § 15A-194 (setting of execution date triggered, in part, upon denial of motion for appropriate relief).
- 9. Staying this case would serve the interests of judicial economy given the pendency of the RJA-related litigation in the Supreme Court of North Carolina and the potential impact on the instant case of further litigation as a result of any opinion issued by that Court.

In light of the foregoing, particularly the pendency of the on-going RJA litigation before the Supreme Court of North Carolina, this Court finds it appropriate to formally place this case in abeyance. The Court therefore ORDERS that this case shall be temporarily stayed until further notice. The Court's prior injunction order issued in 2014 shall remain in full force and effect during the pendency of the temporary stay.
