In fiscal year 2003-2004, the General Assembly authorized and the Council of State approved special indebtedness of \$300,000,000 in certificates of participation (COPs) to be used for the repair and renovation of State facilities. Over 500 projects were selected for funding as presented to the Council of State. The following changes to the project list are for the Council's information as no formal action is required.
