

February 2024 North Carolina Bar Examination:

Of the 484 applicants who made initial application, 58 withdrew, failed to appear, or did not finish the examination and 2 applicants' application was returned due to a dishonored check for application fees.

July 2024 North Carolina Bar Examination:

Of the 950 applicants who made initial application, 69 withdrew, failed to appear, or did not finish the examination and 1 applicants' application was returned due to a dishonored check for application fees.
