**RE:** Report on Interstate Compact Fees Used to Support Training Programs and Equipment

Purchases

DATE: October 1, 2025

Pursuant to S.L. 2023-134 Section 19C.1.(a) and (b), notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 148-65.7, fees collected for the Interstate Compact Fund during the 2023-2025 fiscal biennium may be used by the Department of Adult Correction during the 2023-2025 fiscal biennium to provide training programs and equipment purchases for the Division of Community Supervision and Reentry, but only to the extent sufficient funds remain available in the Fund to support the mission of the Interstate Compact Program.

No later than October 1 of each fiscal year, the Department of Adult Correction shall report to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Justice and Public Safety on the amount of funds used pursuant to this section and for what purposes the funds were used.



### **Overview of Interstate Compact**

It is the purpose of this compact and the Interstate Commission, through means of joint and cooperative action among the compacting states: (1) To provide the framework for the promotion of public safety and to protect the rights of victims through the control and regulation of the interstate movement of offenders in the community; (2) To provide for the effective tracking, supervision, and rehabilitation of these offenders by the sending and receiving states; and (3) To equitably distribute the costs, benefits, and obligations of the compact among the compacting states.

#### Financial Overview for Fiscal Year 2024-2025

In the fiscal year 2024-2025, the Department of Adult Correction allocated \$133,448.50 from the Interstate Compact Fee Fund for various training programs and equipment purchases:

1. Purchase and Upfitting of a DCS Emergency Response Mobile Command Trailer

Vendor: Don Brown Bus Sales, Inc.

o Specifications: Freedom 8.5' x 24' Enclosed Trailer

o Cost: \$108,900.00

2. Best Practices Approach to Supervising Transgender Individuals in a Community Setting – Train the Trainer

Provider: The Moss GroupDates: December 17-18, 2024

o Participants: 14 trainees

Locations: DCS Central Administration, 2020 Yonkers Road, Raleigh, NC

o Cost: \$24,548.50

Furthermore, an amount of \$48,852.80 was allocated to administrative costs associated with the Interstate Compact Office, including national membership and subscription fees to the Interstate Commission for Adult Offender Supervision (ICAOS).

Additionally, \$199,845 was transferred from this fund to the main operating fund for the Interstate Compact, as is customary each year.

### **Fund Balance and Future Plans**

As of June 30, 2025, the balance of the Interstate Compact Fee Fund was \$623,510. The plans for 2026 include using the funds for technology upgrades, including new webcams to facilitate virtual Post-Release and Parole Commission Hearings.
