Rationale for Fee: It is planned that the operation of this and any future piers will be supported by receipts generated at the facility. All existing fishing piers on the North Carolina coast charge additional fees for pin fishing rigs, at local market rates. The pier at Nags Head is under construction and is expected to open in May 2011, at which time the proposed fees will be collected.

Who Pays: Adults and youth desiring to fish with pin rigs (live bait) will be charged an additional \$3 to their standard fishing fee.

Number Affected by Fee: An estimated 1000 individuals (adults and youth) will pay the additional \$3 to fish with pin rigs (live bait).
