

G.S. § 143C-9-2, Trust Fund for Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services and Bridge Funding Needs, sets forth the reporting requirement below:

(d) Beginning July 1, 2007, the Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services shall report annually to the Fiscal Research Division on the expenditures made during the preceding fiscal year from the Trust Fund. The report shall identify each expenditure by recipient and purpose and shall indicate the authority under subsection (b) of this section for the expenditure.

There were no expenditures in State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2024-2025 made by the Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Use Services (Division) from the Trust Fund for Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services and Bridge Funding Needs. Per the Office of State Budget and Management, this Fund had a balance of \$151,266.66 on June 30, 2025.
