#### **Transition to NC SBI**

- Strong support from Director Hawley
  - Fully integrated CFSS into the SBI in a supportive and professional manner
  - Clear roles without blurred lines
  - Improved consistency & statewide coordination
  - Stability, structure, and statewide alignment for school safety efforts



## **Operational Update**

- Staffing shortages; applicant quality concerns
- DPI transition issues: \$300K equipment funds reverted
- CFSS worked with DPI Finance in their reluctancy in assisting in preserving federal funds
- CFSS working with federal partners to regain/retain funds
- Need for independent grants management system



### **Operational Update**

- BTAM System Needed for Statewide Reporting
  - Need for statewide integrated BTAM platform
  - Standardizes threat assessments & reduces duplication of entry
- Qualtrics funded only through this school year
- Estimated cost for a system: \$3 million-\$4 million recurring



## **Program Updates**

- Protect Our Student Videos
  - Statewide training & awareness tools
  - Supports safety culture, prevention, and consistency
  - Over 87,000 views
  - Some districts have not complied
- School Safety Trainings
  - In person & virtual trainings
  - Over 1700 participants





## **Funding Summary & Close**

- \$400K nonrecurring training equipment & supplies
- \$3M-4M recurring statewide BTAM system
- SBI transition strengthened school safety posture
