## **Report to the North Carolina General Assembly on Advanced Courses in Mathematics, per G.S. 115C-81.36.(c)**

G.S. 115C-81.36 became law on July 11, 2019, with an expectation for full implementation during the 2019-2020 school year. While implementation was slow to start due to the COVID-19 pandemic, North Carolina has become well-known for the Advanced Courses in Mathematics legislation, also known as Auto-Enrollment in Mathematics programming. NC Department of Public Instruction (NCDPI) has spoken to several other states and the D.C. Board of Education regarding this effort. Most recently, NCDPI presented this topic at the National Association for Gifted Children annual convention with Dr. Jonathan Plucker from Johns Hopkins University. NC is a leader in this area of addressing excellence gaps and meeting the advanced learning needs of students.

G.S. 115C-81.36, Advanced Courses in Mathematics, directs that, when practicable, local boards of education shall offer advanced learning opportunities in mathematics in grades three through five, and advanced courses in mathematics in all grades six and higher. For advanced mathematics courses in grades six and higher, any student scoring at the highest level on the end-of-grade or end-of-course test for the previous mathematics course shall be automatically enrolled in the next advanced mathematics course, unless a parent/guardian provides written notification. The legislation also specifically outlines that a student in seventh grade scoring at the highest level on the seventh-grade mathematics end-of-grade test shall be enrolled in a high school level mathematics course in eighth grade.

In grades 6-12, districts offer various advanced mathematics courses to meet student needs, interests, and post-secondary plans. Courses are offered in a traditional face-to-face setting as well as provided in an online learning environment by the district or external partner. There are 50 advanced course options available for districts/school to offer in North Carolina, including accelerated and compacted middle school content, Honors, University, Community College, Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, and Cambridge International Education high school courses.

In accordance with this legislation, NCDPI shall submit a report to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee containing data collected for the current school year on the number and demographic information of students who were *eligible* for advanced mathematics courses under this section, including high school level mathematics courses in eighth grade. In addition, the report will include the number and demographic information for all *eligible* students who *were placed* in advanced mathematics courses and those who *were not placed* in advanced mathematics courses. Finally, the report shall include information on the type and

format of advanced mathematics courses provided and any feedback provided by local boards of education on the implementation of G.S. 115C-81.36.

To comply with this legislation, NCDPI obtained enrollment data for all students currently enrolled in grades six and higher who were *eligible* for advanced courses from the NC Student Information System (NC-SIS) for all Local Education Agencies (LEAs) and Charter Schools.

## Summary of Findings

*Based on the 2025-26 data, the following observations are noted based on Tables 1-8 found on pages 8-53:*

- There are **70,763 students** in grades 6-12 scoring at the highest level on either an end-of-grade or end-of-course mathematics assessment at the end of 2024-25 school year. This is a **25% growth** over the previous year of 14,218 more students. This is a significant increase in students scoring at Level 5. NCDPI has noted increases in the number of students eligible every year since reporting began in 2021.
- In alignment with the legislation, these students were then automatically eligible for placement in an advanced mathematics course in the current 2025-26 school year.
  - **92% (65,206) of eligible students are currently placed in an advanced mathematic course.** While this percentage is a decrease by 1% in the overall placement of students, there are still 9,725 more students placed overall in advanced math courses. This marks the highest number of eligible students placed into advanced mathematics courses since reporting began.
  - **7% (5,557) of eligible students are not currently placed in an advanced mathematics course.** This is an increase of 1% in the overall percentage of students not placed compared to the previous year across all PSUs.
- **District level data show that:**
  - 2 districts are currently placing less than 15% of eligible students.
  - 15 districts are currently placing 16%-70% of eligible students
  - 7 districts are currently placing 71%-80% of eligible students
  - 50 districts are currently placing 80%-95% of eligible students
  - 41 districts are placing >95% of eligible students.
- The decrease in eligible students being placed in advanced mathematics courses can be seen throughout the disaggregated data.
  - In the grade level data, decreases were seen in multiple grade levels with the largest decreases shown in grades 6 and 12. These grades have historically reported the lowest percentage of students placed in advanced mathematics courses. **Grade 12**

**students were only placed at 75%, which is a 7% decrease from the previous year.**

- In the student racial/ethnic group data, there is/are:
  - **a 4% increase in student placement for the American Indian or Alaska Native student group.** This is the first time this number has increased more than other student groups. NCDPI looks forward to working with districts to understand what factors led to this growth.
  - **decreases in the percentage of eligible students placed in advanced mathematics courses among Black or African American, Hispanic or Latino students, Native Hawaiian/other Pacific Islander, and White students, ranging from 1%-6%.** The Black or African American student group decreased the most in advanced math course placement at 6% less.
- Other student groups being placed at lower rates across grades 6-12 in advanced mathematics courses are **English Language learners (21% not placed), Exceptional Children (16% not placed) and Homeless (21% not placed).** These students are less likely to be placed than other students across grades 6-12.
- **In the 8<sup>th</sup> grade data, overall number and percentage of students placed in Math 1 in middle school has remained steady at >95% with <5% not placed.**
  - Black or African American and Hispanic students are least likely to be placed in Math 1 in middle school with placement rates of 92% and 95% respectively.
  - While the percent of males and females overall placed in advanced mathematics courses in grade 8 was >95% for both females and males, there are fewer females (6,164) than males (8,000) who scored a Level 5.

#### **Feedback from LEAs reporting process and efforts to implement the legislation:**

1. Many LEAs have expressed concern about the number of 12th grade students who may have scored at the highest level on the NC Math 3 end-of-course mathematics assessment and who are currently not enrolled in an advanced course. During this report window, only 75% of eligible 12th grade students are enrolled in an advanced mathematics course (down from 82% last year). LEA personnel believe this happens because either the students have met the graduation requirements in mathematics and have chosen not to enroll in mathematics courses or they are choosing to enroll in a less challenging mathematics course. The timing of the report could also play into this since the spring semester may not be scheduled yet.
2. LEAs continue to express a desire to be able to report those cases in which a student is not placed in an advanced course due to a parent's written request to help better understand

the context for local data.

3. Smaller districts continue to express concerns regarding availability for mathematics teachers, thus making course access challenging.

### **Next Steps for NCDPI:**

- Auto-enrollment in mathematics is a policy shift that has had great outcomes for NC public school students. What is clear though is that mindsets and practices need to be further developed so that even more eligible students can be placed in advanced courses and eligible students' outstanding potential can be responded to appropriately.
- Last year, there were 21 districts placing less than 70% of eligible students compared to 17 districts this year. This is positive movement, but much work still needs to occur for these districts to ensure access to advanced learning opportunities for eligible students. NCDPI will reach out to these districts to provide support and technical assistance due to placing less than 70% of eligible students.
- While there are more students being placed in all student groups, the percentage of eligible students placed continues to decrease for certain student groups. This is a trend that NCDPI will work with our districts in better understanding and mitigating.
- NCDPI will continue to work with our state reporting system to find a mechanism for LEAs to share which students who are eligible for placement in an advanced math course but who have a parent/guardian's written request to not be placed in the advanced course.
- NCDPI will investigate what student supports and communication efforts need to be put in place for better placement of English Language learner, Exceptional Children, and Homeless students in advanced courses.
- Furthermore, NCDPI will support districts in analyzing data to broaden access for advanced mathematics courses and work to resolve issues of implementation.
- The excellence gap is lessening, but there is more work to do.

### **Data Tables, based on legislative requirements:**

The data tables below respond to the legislated requirements documenting the *eligible* students who were either *placed or not placed* in advanced mathematics courses, and disaggregating the information by sex, grade level, and ethnicity/race. These tables include an overview of grades 6-12, and a specific look at grade 8 data, as the legislation specifically requires reporting for grade 8 students eligible for enrollment in high school content for all Public School Units. Additionally, detailed tables of the demographic information, including sex, race/ethnic group, migrant status, homeless status, English Learner status, Academically or Intellectually Gifted (AIG) status, and Exceptional Children (EC) status for all *eligible*

students placed and not placed listed by each of the 115 traditional LEAs. Finally, an overview table of all LEAs is provided with the total number of eligible students and of those, the percentage of students placed in advanced mathematics courses.

Note that the data tables do *not* represent comprehensive enrollment in advanced mathematics courses; rather, the information reflects those students who scored at the highest level on an end-of-grade or end-of-course mathematics assessment in the previous school year and are therefore automatically eligible for advanced mathematics course enrollment in the current school year, as outlined in the legislation.
