Introduction

N.C.G.S. 7A-350 requires the North Carolina Administrative Office of the Courts (NCAOC) to report on criminal cost waivers. Specifically, G.S. 7A-350 provides as follows:

§ 7A-350. Annual report on criminal court cost waivers.

The Administrative Office of the Courts shall maintain records of all cases in which a judge makes a finding of just cause to grant a waiver of criminal court costs under G.S. 7A-304(a) and shall report on those waivers to the chairs of the House of Representatives and Senate Appropriations Committees on Justice and Public Safety and the chairs of the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Justice and Public Safety by February 1 of each year. The report shall aggregate the waivers by the district in which the waiver or waivers were granted and by the name of each judge granting a waiver or waivers.

NCAOC respectfully submits this report pursuant to the legislative mandate.

Report Parameters

NCAOC is responsible for providing recordkeeping guidelines, training and support to the state's trial courts. On October 13, 2025, NCAOC completed the migration from the legacy Criminal Case Information System, Clerk Component (CCIS-CC) to Enterprise Justice (Odyssey) in all 100 counties. Prior to the completion of this migration, on June 6, 2023, NCAOC issued a memorandum providing the definitions and proper use of money statuses and a case event detailed in the next section of this report.

In Enterprise Justice, money statuses are consolidated into one case event titled, "G.S. 7A-304(a) Costs Judicially Waived or Partially Waived." The attached Table 1 includes criminal court money statuses by county, while Table 2 includes criminal court money statuses by judge. All money statuses are presented in Tables 1 and 2 to provide all relevant available data, although there may be some slight variation in use among the counties.

Criminal Court Money Statuses

In Enterprise Justice, criminal court money statuses are either generated by the system or entered by a clerk as a case event. When a defendant pleads guilty or is convicted, based on the convicted offense, Enterprise Justice automatically applies most applicable costs, fees, and fines. If any individual cost, fee, or fine is reduced or eliminated, a criminal court monetary status case event must be created in Enterprise Justice. Based on the order of the presiding judge, the clerk enters changes to the presumptive amounts and enters an applicable money status.

G.S. 7A-304(a) Costs Judicially Waived or Partially Waived: This money status is entered into Enterprise Justice as a case event by the clerk when a judge waives or remits a G.S. 7A-304(a) monetary obligation in its entirety, or reduces but does not eliminate the obligation. In 2024, however, NCAOC discovered that some system users were attaching non-G.S. 7A-304(a) monetary obligations to this case event. As a result, the custom report created to aggregate the number of cases and amounts remitted in calendar year 2024, provided a significant over count of both qualifying cases and costs remitted. This overcount continued in calendar year 2025 as more counties migrated to Enterprise Justice throughout the year. To prepare a more accurate estimation of actual case numbers and G.S. 7A-304(a) costs remitted,



NCAOC analyzed the most frequent case amounts remitted in the report to determine their eligibility, and removed those that were proven to be ineligible, based on either specific case information or the statutory list of eligible costs. **The resulting figures are believed to still be a significant overcount, however, there is not enough evidence in the available data to impute the numbers any further.** In areas where local officials implemented some form of driver’s license restoration efforts (for example, in Orange and Chatham counties) in partnership with the North Carolina Equal Access to Justice Commission, their numbers will be disproportionately high. These amounts generally represent very old cases, with little to no prospect of ever being collected. To correct this for 2026 and future years, NCAOC will reinforce training directing system users to utilize this event only for cases in which the judge determines there is just cause, via a written order, to grant a waiver, or partial waiver, of G.S. 7A-304(a) costs only.

Summary

This report includes information on criminal court money statuses by county and by judge for calendar year 2025, and in NCAOC’s best estimate, it is inclusive of all money statuses involving a full or partial waiver of G.S. 7A-304(a) costs.
