5 **21 NCAC 63 .0210 PROVISIONAL LICENSES**

6 (a) The Board shall issue a provisional license to any person who meets the requirements in G.S. 90B-7(f).

7 (b) Applications and forms shall be obtained from and returned to the Board Office.

8 ~~(c) The Board shall assess an application fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for processing each application.~~

9 ~~(d)(c)~~ Prior to practicing clinical social work, applicants must demonstrate in writing that, in the event of a clinical
10 emergency they have immediate access to a licensed mental health professional who has agreed to provide to them
11 emergency clinical consultation to assure that standards of clinical social work practice are maintained.
12 Provisionally- licensed clinical social workers shall ~~immediately~~ notify the Board in writing of any change in such
13 access.

14 ~~(e)(d)~~ Each provisional licensee must be supervised as set forth in G.S. 90B-7(f), and, shall receive on-going
15 appropriate supervision, as defined in Rule .0211(a)(2) of this Chapter, until the provisional licensee is licensed as a
16 Licensed Clinical Social Worker.

17 ~~(f)(e)~~ All provisional licensees shall submit reports of their clinical social work experience and supervision on the
18 appropriate Board form(s) every six months for review and evaluation by the Board.

19 ~~(g)(f)~~ To prevent a lapse in licensure, provisional licensees who desire to become Licensed Clinical Social Workers
20 shall complete the application process for the Licensed Clinical Social Worker classification ~~and submit the~~
21 ~~application fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00)~~ early enough to allow 30 days for administrative processing and
22 Board action prior to the expiration of the provisional license.
