## **Dear Members:**

G.S. § 1-617(b) requires the Attorney General to submit to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations and the Chairs of the Appropriations Subcommittees on Justice and Public Safety an annual report on the number of qui tam cases under the North Carolina False Claims Act (G.S. § 1-605 through 1-618) pending in the State and the number of qui tam cases pending in other jurisdictions involving the State, the number of qui tam cases under the North Carolina False Claims Act that were settled, the number of qui tam cases in which judgment was entered, and the amount of proceeds paid to qui tam plaintiffs during the previous calendar year.

For the period January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011, the Attorney General's report pursuant to G.S. § 1-617(b) is as follows:
