UNC General Administration was authorized by the UNC Board of Governors to begin a system-wide performance project to implement energy conservation measures across the UNC system, involving all campuses with the exception of ECSU, NCSU, UNC-CH and UNCW. The project is estimated to cost a maximum of \$25,000,000 and the debt will be repaid with guaranteed energy savings, as allowed by G.S. 143-64.17F.
