(NCPC) to develop and administer an early literacy initiative pilot, known as "Read NC." Read NC was to focus on increasing the early literacy skills of children who are most at risk for reading below grade level. The provision also allowed NCPC to hire four development officers and provide additional funds for rural partnerships.

The provision stipulated that the funds could not be expended until January 1, 2013, pending a determination by the Office of State Budget and Management (OSBM) that there was adequate funding for the Medicaid budget for the 2012-2013 fiscal year.
