ⁱ The One North Carolina Fund statute requires that grant agreements include, and grant agreements do include, the ability to recapture funds for a grantee's failure to comply with specific requirements of the agreement. *See N.C. Gen. Stat.* §143B-437.72(b)(7). Section 2.7 of The Guidelines for One North Carolina, promulgated under the One NC Statute also requires that agreements contain recapture provisions for nonperformance.

ii Job Development Investment Grant Program. The ability to recapture funds for failing to maintain operations at the project location for at least 150% of the grant term is statutorily required to be, and is in fact, reflected in JDIG Agreements. This requirement is also reflected in Section 11.3 of the Criteria for

Operation and Implementation of the Job Development Investment Grant Program. There are other circumstances of reduced activity that have resulted in grantees voluntarily repaying grant amounts previously disbursed.

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iii The ability to recapture funds for performance failures is statutorily required to be, and is in fact, reflected in the N.C. Green Business Fund grant agreements and Program Guidelines. See §143B-437.6(5).

^{iv} The Industrial Development Fund awards grants to units of local government and in the event the grant is tied to job creation, the statute (§ 143B-437.01) provides for repayment or recapture of grant payments disbursed should a company fail to create the required number of jobs.
