SUBJECT:

Expenditures for Emergency Capital Projects

In accordance with G.S. 120-76.1 the following expenditures were approved without consulting the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations because of an emergency that posed an imminent threat to public health or public safety.

<u>University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill (UNC-CH):</u> On November 5, 2013, Cobb Hall received extensive damage to portions of the attic and fourth floors of the dormitory due to a fire. The repairs to the building system include HVAC, Telecommunications', Electrical, Life Safety, and Architectural. The fourth floor of the dormitory will be offline until repairs can be made. The estimated cost to design and construct permanent repairs is \$900,000. The repairs will be funded from housing receipts and the Department of Insurance funds.
