Attached for your information is the Department of Environment and Natural Resources report on Performance Contracting. This report is provided to you pursuant to § 143-64.17H which states: "A State governmental unit that enters into a guaranteed energy savings contract must report the contract and the terms of the contract to the State Energy Office of the Department of Commerce within 30 days of the date the contract is entered into. In addition, within 60 days after each annual anniversary date of a guaranteed energy savings contract, the State governmental unit must report the status of the contract to the State Energy Office, including any details required by the State Energy Office. The State Energy Office shall compile the information for each fiscal year and report it to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations and to the Local Government Commission annually by December 1. In compiling the information, the State Energy Office shall include information on the energy savings expected to be realized from a contract and shall evaluate whether expected savings have in fact been realized." The attached study report is submitted to fulfill this requirement.

2013 Performance Contracting Annual Report

Summary:

North Carolina law allows state agencies and universities to use a Performance Contracting process to implement and finance major facility upgrades that save energy and reduce utility expenditures. A Performance Contract or Guaranteed Energy Savings Contract is a design-build procurement process with a single point of responsibility. An Energy Service Company, pre-qualified by the state's Utility Savings Initiative, designs and proposes a package of energy cost reduction measures, installs or implements those cost reduction measures, and guarantees the savings of the cost reductions. The facility's owner pays for the package over time using the stream of revenue provided by the guaranteed energy reduction measures.

Since legislative approval of Performance Contracting for North Carolina state governmental units, construction has been completed on 10 performance contracts. These 10 projects at state agencies and universities represent a facility upgrade investment of \$134.5 million. So far, there is energy savings data available for five of these completed projects. The guaranteed utility savings achieved through these five projects is paying for the project's debt retirement and annual fees, and has exceeded the contractors' guaranteed savings by \$518,600.

Of the other performance contract projects in progress, five contracts have been approved by the Council of State and are in the construction phase. An additional five performance contracts are in the investment grade audit phase and one agency is in process of reviewing the proposals and selecting an Energy Service Contractor. The total of 21 contracts, in process or completed, represent an estimated project investment of \$241.8 million. The current legislative cap on performance contracts is \$500 million.

The projects that completed construction after 1/1/2011 or are in construction now have provided employment for approximately 1,310 people.
