Pursuant to Session Law 2013-360, Section 12J.1.(e), the Division of Budget and Analysis respectfully submits this letter requesting two changes to the Child Care and Development Fund (CCDF) block grant within the Department of Health and Human Services.

First, the CCDF funds for local subsidized child care services support were certified under the Division of Child Development and Early Education (DCDEE) per Section 12J.1.(a) of Session Law 2013-360; however, these funds need to be budgeted in the Division of Social Services (DSS). The department requests these funds designated for local subsidized child care services support transfer from DCDEE, where it is held in reserve, to DSS, where it will be spent by county departments of social services. Consistent with Session Law 2013-360, \$13,274,413 in CCDF will be used for subsidized child care services support.

Second, the amount appropriated in the SFY 13-14 CCDF legislative block grant plan for subsidized child care services support was based on funding the allowance that county departments of social services may use for administrative costs at three percent of the county's total child care subsidy funds allocated in the CCDF block grant plan or \$80,000, whichever is greater. However, Section 12B.7.(a) of Session Law 2013-360 directed DCDEE to fund the allowance that county departments of social services may use for administrative costs at four percent of the county's total child care subsidy funds allocated in the CCDF block grant plan or \$80,000, whichever is greater. Therefore, to address this difference, Section 4.7 of Session Law 2013-363 allows DCDEE to adjust the allocations in the CCDF block grant under Section 12J.1.(a). This adjustment to the allocations decreases CCDF subsidized child care services and increases CCDF subsidized child care services support by \$2,608,015. The maximum amount counties may use for services support is \$15,882,428. However, it is possible that this amount may be less, as some counties may choose to use some of those funds for direct services.
