SUBJECT: Expenditures for Emergency Capital Projects

In accordance with G.S. 120-76.1 the following expenditures were approved without consulting the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations because of an emergency that posed an imminent threat to public health or public safety.

University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill (UNC-CH): Implemented emergency contracting procedures to address a matter of health and safety on campus. Due to the recent extreme cold weather, building systems equipment was significantly damaged and must be replaced in two buildings, McGavran Greenburg, and the Lineberger Cancer Research Center. These facilities house critical research and in the case of McGavran Greenburg also house an animal facility and BSL3 Lab. The estimated cost for the repairs is \$450,000. The University will provide non-recurring funds for this effort.
