Justification for Position (including description of duties and responsibilities):

The Exceptional Children Division is schedule to complete its new CECAS Comprehensive Exceptional Children Accountability System) database by the end of 2004. The current contract Project Manager will be phased out. A position is needed to oversee the daily operation of the CECAS.
