19 than those called by the chair. The Board may annually select one member to attend a national

8 who submits a properly completed application on a form approved by the Board, pays the
9 required fee, and is determined after inspection to be in compliance with the provisions of this
10 Chapter and the Board's rules.

11 (b) The Board shall adopt rules for the operation, permitting, and inspection of mobile
12 cosmetic art shops, including standards for facilities, personnel, and safety and sanitary
13 requirements. All permitting and operating requirements provided by this Chapter or by rules
14 adopted by the Board pursuant to this Chapter that apply to cosmetic art shops shall also apply
15 to mobile cosmetic art shops, except to the extent that the requirements conflict with this section
16 or with any rules adopted by the Board pursuant to this section.

17 (c) In addition to the requirements of this Chapter, individuals and the vehicles they
18 operate while providing mobile manicuring services shall be subject to the provisions of (i)
19 Chapter 20 of the General Statutes, (ii) Title 19A of the North Carolina Administrative Code,
20 (iii) all applicable OSHA requirements, and (iv) all local laws and ordinances regulating business
21 establishments.

22 (d) A mobile cosmetic art shop must be equipped with a functional sink and toilet
23 facilities and must maintain an adequate supply of clean water and wastewater storage capacity.

24 (e) No manicuring may be performed in a mobile cosmetic art shop while the mobile
25 cosmetic art shop is moving. The mobile cosmetic art shop must be safely parked in a legal
26 parking spot at all times while patrons are present inside the mobile cosmetic art shop.

27 (f) A mobile cosmetic art shop owner must maintain a permanent business address at
28 which records of appointments, itineraries, license numbers, and vehicle identification numbers
29 for each mobile cosmetic art shop being operated shall be kept and made available for verification
30 and inspection by the Board and at which all correspondence from the Board can be received.

31 (g) To facilitate periodic inspections of mobile cosmetic art shops, prior to the beginning
32 of each month, the owner of the mobile cosmetic art shop shall provide to the Board a written
33 monthly itinerary listing locations, dates, and hours of operation for the mobile cosmetic art shop.

19 (a) The Board shall furnish a copy of its rules relating to sanitary management of
20 cosmetic art ~~shops~~shops, mobile cosmetic art shops, and cosmetic art schools to each ~~shop~~shop,
21 mobile cosmetic art shop, and school licensed by the Board. Each ~~shop~~shop, mobile cosmetic
22 art shop and school shall post the rules in a conspicuous place.

23 (b) The Board shall furnish a copy of its rules relating to curriculum and schools to each
24 licensed cosmetic art school. Each cosmetic art school shall make these rules available to all
25 teachers and students.

26 **"§ 88B-27. Inspections.**

27 Any inspector or other authorized representative of the Board may enter any cosmetic art
28 ~~shop or~~shop, mobile cosmetic art shop, or cosmetic art school to inspect it for compliance with
29 this Chapter and the Board's rules. All persons practicing cosmetic art in a ~~shop~~shop, mobile
30 cosmetic art shop, or school shall, upon request, present satisfactory proof of identification.
31 Satisfactory proof shall be in the form of a photographic driver's license or photographic
32 identification card issued by any state, federal, or other government entity. The Board may

34 inspected as a condition for license renewal.
