Dear Senator Basnight and Speakers Black and Morgan:

Pursuant to applicable law, the Alcohol Law Enforcement Division reports its intent to use \$ 99,551.00 in Federal Seizure funds as a grant match for an extensive program to reduce the consumption of alcohol by underage individuals.

The Alcohol Law Enforcement Division intends to use these funds to further its goals of Education, Training, Regulation and Enforcement of the alcohol beverage control laws in an extensive program to reduce alcohol consumption by underage individuals. This program includes a new component involving the education of middle school students regarding alcohol consumption, an expansion of the current *Keys to Life Program*, voluntary seller/server training and licensing program, and a qualitative enforcement effort.

This prospectus requires one grant funded administrative assistant position to facilitate the implementation, scheduling, data entry, media presentations, and product evaluation of the program. This position is funded for two years.

As of August 31, 2003, the Federal Seizure Fund held by the Alcohol Law Enforcement Division had an unencumbered balance of \$225,194.00.
