
Justification for Position (including description of duties and responsibilities):

Five time limited, full-time positions to focus on DWI cases and take impaired drivers off the road; to have an ADA be a traffic law specialist dedicated to traffic offense prosecution and develop a training program; add a DWI prosecutor to handle driving while impaired cases; to arrest and prosecute DWI absconders and lead a DWI Strike Force; have an ADA dedicated to the preparation and prosecution of cases due to alcohol and dangerous driving related crashes.
