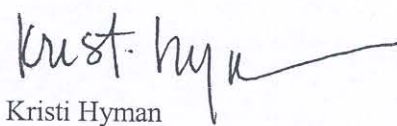
Pursuant to Section 15.5.(a) of Chapter 276 of the 2005 Session Laws, please find the report of the Department of Justice on the receipts, costs for, number of criminal record checks performed in connection with applications for concealed handgun permits, and number of applications received and approved for firearms safety courses for the Fiscal Year 2005-2006. The information described below is collected from the Division of Criminal Information, the Justice Academy and the Criminal Justice Training and Standards Section, all of which are involved in this program.

As you may know, in 2001, the General Assembly increased the State Bureau of Investigation's budgeted receipts by \$1.5 million and decreased state appropriations by the same amount. As a result, these over-budgeted receipts not only support the cost of concealed weapon permit activities, they support the salaries and operating expenses of sworn field agents, the crime laboratory and other law enforcement functions.
