Name of Fee: Cabin and Improved Group Camp Rental Fees

**Purpose of Fee:** To offset the cost on operating and maintaining the facilities.

**Current Fee**: Improved group camp (max. of 35): \$35

Improved group camp (max. of 100): \$90

Family cabin: \$300/week during the summer or \$60/day

**Revenue Generated (2001-2002 FY):** \$103,022

**Proposed Fee:** Improved group camp (max. of 35): \$40

Improved group camp (max. of 100): \$105

Family cabin: \$500/week during the summer or \$100/night.

**Additional Revenue Generated:** \$60,094

**Projected Total Annual Revenue:** \$163,115

**Rationale for Fee Increase:** The cost of operating and maintaining the cabins and group camps increases as the age of the facilities increases. The fee increases would also keep North Carolina in line with surrounding states and help offset the budget shortfall.

Who Pays: Park visitors renting family cabins and group camps.
