Revenue Generated (FY 2005-06): \$10,062,353.28

Proposed Fee: Variable based on new fee category. See attachment.

Additional Revenue Generated (Based upon FY 2005-06 Payments): \$3,356,400.

Projected Total Annual Revenue: \$13,418,753.

Rationale for Fee Increase: State regulation (15A NCAC 2R .0402) requires that EEP annually evaluate the actual costs associated with compensatory mitigation and adjust fees as appropriate. The program recently completed an in-depth analysis of restoration project costs with the assistance of the academic community and has determined that the current schedule of fees is insufficient to offset actual costs associated with program projects.

Who Pays: Voluntary program participants including private development companies, individuals and local governments.

Number Affected by Fee: EEP received 152 individual payments for wetlands and stream mitigation during FY 2005-06.

Inception Date of Fee: August 1, 1998.

Date of Last Fee Change: Regulatory revision effective April 1, 2003 and annual adjustments for inflation published every July 1 since then.
