












### **Clean Water Partners Grants, FY09**

# **Job Creation Programs**










### **EIF Water & Sewer Grants, FY09**

- 674 new jobs




#### **Brownfields Grants, FY09**

### **Rural Health Care Grants, FY09**


- 2 grants








#### **CDC Grants, FY09**


- 23 grants
- \$1 million
- \$3.1 million leveraged
- 10,800 residents served
- 320 home foreclosures prevented
- + 5 OIC grants totaling \$270,000





#### **NC STEP Program, FY09**

- 30 sites (45 towns)
- 20 strategies completed (33 towns)
- 55 projects completed
- 52 projects under way
- 7 workshops, 421 participants
- Direct technical assistance for 847







#### **Microenterprise Loan Program, FY09**

- 56 loans
- \$361,700
- Average loan of \$6,459
- 39% to women, 52% to minorities, 18% to low-income individuals
