








Clean Water Partners Grants, FY10 Supplemental








EIF Water & Sewer Grants, FY10

Building Reuse Grants, FY10












CDC Grants, FY10


- 23 grants

- + 4 OIC grants totaling \$215,000






NC STEP Program, FY10

- \$13 million in 70 other Rural Center grants








Microenterprise Loan Program, FY10

- 45 loans

- \$500,000 appropriation


Through June 30, 2010 --






