To: Chairs

This letter is to renew the request for consultation contained in our letter dated October 17, 2007 (copy attached). Rule 21 NCAC 18B.0209, adopted on October 16, 2007, raises the examination fees from \$75.00 to \$90.00. Rule 21 NCAC 18B.0404, also adopted on October 16, 2007, raises the license fee, now \$60.00, \$100.00 or \$150.00 depending on the license level, by \$15.00 each.

Both changes are well within the statutory authority contained in G.S. 87-44 and both cleared the public hearing before the Board and approval by the Administrative Rules Review Commission without objection.

The fees have not changed in five years and the cost to the Board for personnel, outside exam administration and complaint investigation has increased. The statutory authority for the fee changes is G.S. 87-44.
