Funding for this acquisition is provided by Natural Heritage Trust Fund (\$103,400) and Parks and Recreation Trust Fund (\$899,800).

Acquisition of this property will provide connectivity to the state park along the Eno River. Eno River State Park currently has 3,947 acres out of a planned 4,793 acres. The Eno River Association will be reimbursed for overhead and direct expenses associated with the acquisition. Funding for this acquisition is provided by the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund (\$320,717) and Clean Water Management Trust Fund (\$643,000).

Funding for this acquisition is provided by the Clean Water Management Trust Fund (\$180,436), private donations (\$131,876) and proposed funding for the balance (\$130,188) to be provided by Natural Heritage Trust Fund.

ANNUAL RENTAL: \$1.00 for the term

COMMENTS: Short-term ground lease used to facilitate the construction and financing of Phase 1 of the Kenan Stadium Expansion, pursuant to Session Law 2008-204. Project consists of the addition of two floors including 11,355 sq. ft. of office space, 289 premium seats, 17 suites and additional restrooms. Upon completion, the improvements will be purchased by UNC-CH through special indebtedness. Total cost of improvements to be constructed is estimated to be \$24 million. Repayment of the indebtedness will be paid by donor gifts and lease proceeds from suite rentals. This project was approved by the Board of Governors on June 16, 2008. The State Construction Office and Department of Insurance will review and approve the design of the project.
