

Report on State Agency Contracts Performed Outside the United States 2008-2009

§ 143B-59.4(b) of the General Statutes requires the Secretary of Administration to report to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations on the projected number of contracts "which are anticipated to be performed outside the United States." This report was based on information provided to the Division of Purchase and Contract at the Department of Administration.

In 2008-2009 there were a total of 19 contracts awarded by State agencies for work to be performed outside the United States. The total amount of these contracts was for \$1,477,101. The following is a summary of the contracts:
