We appreciate the time spent recently discussing the ongoing financial issues and support given our North Carolina public school athletic programs via the NCHSAA. As the NC General Assembly funds the NCHSAA annually, this matter directly impacts us. Per your request, we have outlined several questions and requests for information of immediate concern.

1. We respectfully request all 990 filings since the 2010 non-profit incorporation.
2. We respectfully request all annually required financial audits since the 2010 non-profit incorporation.
3. You referenced a recent \$4 million refund to local schools.
 - a. Was this a NCHSAA Board authorized directive?
 - b. We respectfully request the formal guidelines governing the refund's distribution.
 - c. How did the NCHSAA come to the appropriation level of \$4 million. Why not \$2 million? Why not \$6 million?
 - d. We respectfully request detailed budgetary figures as to the refund's recipients.
4. We respectfully request the current budgetary amount unencumbered from endowment restrictions.

We respectfully request a full response to the above by February 1, 2021.

As we move forward into 2021, we will undoubtedly have further and more extensive questions and concerns. We greatly appreciate your willingness to assist us as they arise.
