The Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations Subcommittee on Interscholastic Athletics formally requests the appearance of North Carolina State Board of Education ("State Board") Chairman Eric Davis, Vice Chairman Alan Duncan, and General Counsel Allison Schafer, to testify on June 16, 2022, in the Legislative Building Auditorium.
