PETITION THE OLB SUBCOMMITTEE OF THE JLAPO TO REMOVE NCBATE FROM LIST OF OLAS RECOMMENDED FOR CONSOLIDATION WITH ANOTHER REGULATORY ENTITY

This recommendation is made by the NC Board of Athletic Trainer Examiners based on the two factors used by the PED:

- (1) **Annual Revenue.** This factor identifies the size of the OLA as measured by the annual revenue generated by the Board. Scoring was based on the annual revenue from the most recent reporting period. The NCBATE fell in the range of receiving more than \$ 100,000 but less than \$ 500,000 in annual revenue. **For that reason, the Board received a score of five (5).**
- (2) **Financial Solvency.** This factor compares the operating revenues with the expenses generated by the Board. The PED calculated correctly but was given the wrong raw data so, of course, the result was wrong. This may have been because the NCBATE has a different fiscal year (it ends December 31st rather than June 30th) or also in part because of a change in terminology. The PED determined scoring based on the ratio of the net position to annual expenses as reported on the most recently available financial statement. BUT, in any case, the Board has subsequently submitted to the PED and this Committee the corrected figures as supplied by the Board's CPA and consistent with its Audit. **This financial solvency score is ten (10) rather than the earlier financial solvency score of zero (0).**

THE PED REQUIRED ALL BOARDS TO OBTAIN A SCORE OF TEN (10). THE NCBATE OBTAINS A SCORE OF FIFTEEN (15) USING THE CORRECTED INFORMATION AND SHOULD NOT BE CONSOLIDATED.
