1) ADDRESS OF THE BOARD

1a) LICENSEES SUPERVISED BY THE BOARD

The number of licensees supervised by the Board as of March 31, 2015, was 20,238.

2) EXAMINATION APPLICATIONS RECEIVED

The Board received 3,746 applications for the examination sections administered between April 1, 2014, and March 31, 2015.

3) EXAMINATION APPLICATIONS DENIED

The Board denied 33 applications received for the examination sections administered between April 1, 2014, and March 31, 2015. These applications were denied for failure to meet the requirements for examination as established by North Carolina General Statute 93-12 and Title 21, Chapter 08F of the North Carolina Administrative Code.

4) EXAMINATION APPLICANTS TAKING THE EXAM

Between April 1, 2014, and March 31, 2015, the Board approved 3,713 applicants to take the examination and 4,945 sections of the examination were actually taken.

5) INITIAL LICENSES ISSUED

During the fiscal year, the Board issued 601 original CPA licenses.

5a) EXAMINATION APPLICANTS FAILING THE EXAMINATION

Between April 1, 2014, and March 31, 2015, 639 individuals failed at least one of the four sections of the examination.

6) RECIPROCAL LICENSES APPLIED FOR

During the fiscal year, the Board received 276 applications for licensure by reciprocity.

7) RECIPROCAL LICENSES ISSUED

During the fiscal year, the Board issued 276 reciprocal CPA licenses.

7a) COMPLAINTS

During the fiscal year, the Board received 432 complaints on licensees and non-CPAs.

7b) DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

During the fiscal year, the Board took disciplinary or other action against 81 licensees and non-CPAs.

LICENSES SUSPENDED OR REVOKED 8)

During the fiscal year, the Board suspended 4 licenses. The Board revoked 7 licenses during the fiscal year.

9) LICENSES TERMINATED

During the fiscal year, the Board terminated 10 CPA licenses for reasons other than failure to pay the required renewal fee.

ANTICIPATED AMENDMENTS TO BOARD STATUTES 10)

At this time, no amendments to Board statutes are anticipated.

ANTICIPATED CHANGES OR ADOPTIONS TO BOARD RULES 11)

As required by the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH), the Board has published rules for re-adoption of the periodic review of the Board rules.
