Eliminate the term "warrants" under Board Secretary duties. Current language reads that the Board can only pay expenses after a warrant is issued by the Board Secretary.

Add the ability of the Board to accept electronically submitted complaints. The language now reads the complaint must "be in writing and shall be sworn to."

89C-17

Add the ability of the Board to email renewals. Current language reads "the Board shall notify by mail" . . . And tied to this add a definition for "mail" under 89C-3.

89C-10

Change the current language of "The investigation of a licensee is confidential until the Board issues a citation to the licensee." to add ", or (ii) approves any action authorized under this Chapter against a nonlicensee."
