
- (1a) The total number of licensees supervised by the board is 969.
(2) The number of persons who applied to the board for examination was 29.
(3) The number who were refused examination is 0.
(4) The number who took the exam was 33.
(5) The number to whom initial licenses were issued was 25.
(5a) The number who failed the examination is 21.
(6) The number who applied for license by reciprocity or comity was 0.
(7) The number who were granted licenses by reciprocity or comity was 3.
(7a) The number of official complaints received involving licensed and unlicensed activities was 161.
(7b) The number of disciplinary actions taken against licensees, or other actions taken against non-licensees, including injunctive relief was 117.
(8) The number of licenses suspended or revoked was 32.
(9) The number of licenses terminated for any reason other than failure to pay the required renewal fee was 1.
