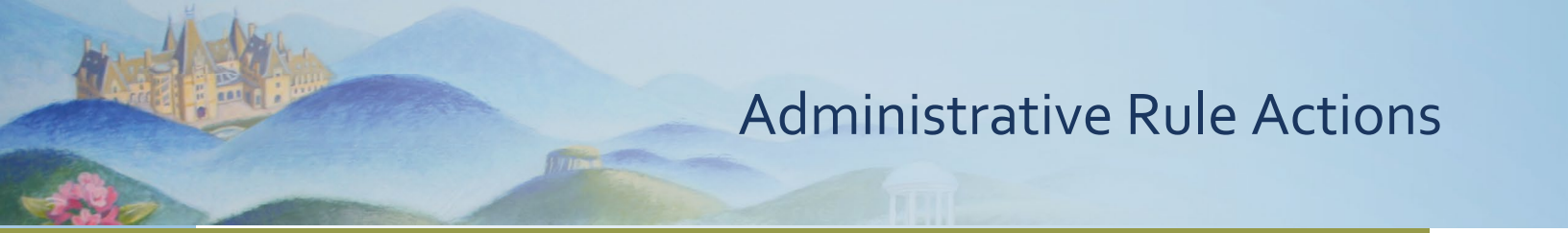

Licenses are renewed for a period of two years. License renewal fees are deferred and recognized as revenue over the two-year period to which they relate.
