- (1a) 1378 licensees
- (2) Fifty-eight individuals applied for examination.

- (4) Fifty-two individuals appeared for examination.
- (5) Licenses were issued to thirty-one individuals as a result of the examinations; One license was issued to individuals in accordance with the provisions of N.C.G.S. 93B-15.1
- (5a) Twenty-one individuals failed the examinations.
- (6) The Board does not differentiate between applicants who have been licensed in other jurisdictions prior to applying for a North Carolina license and those applying immediately following graduation and who do not hold a license to practice elsewhere; all applicants are required to take the clinical/practicum examination.
