AIRPORT AREA HEIGHT RESTRICTION	https://library.municode.com/nc/currituck_county/codes/code_of_ordinances?nodeId=COOR_CH2.5AIAARHERE_S2.5-1PU	CHAPTER 2.5, AIRPORT AREA HEIGHT RESTRICTIONS	An ordinance regulating and restricting the height of structures in the vicinity of the Currituck County Airport by creating the appropriate zones and establishing the boundaries thereof; providing for changes in the restrictions and boundaries of such zones; defining certain terms used herein; referring to the Currituck County Airport Area Height Restriction Zone Map which is incorporated in and made a part of this chapter by reference; providing for enforcement; and imposing penalties. Violations of the provisions of this chapter or failure to comply with any of its requirements shall constitute a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of up to \$500.00 or a maximum 30 days imprisonment as provided in G.S. 14-4.

In order for any owner or keeper of a dog or other domestic animal to be found guilty pursuant to this chapter, he must first have received notice from some law enforcement officer, school teacher, school administrator or other person in some way affected by the animal, to keep the dog or other domestic animal off of such public school property or grounds. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be punished as provided by section 1-8.

The violation of any provision of this article shall be a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be punished as provided by section 1-8.

Payment of a fine imposed in criminal proceedings pursuant to this subsection does not relieve a person of his liability for taxes or fees imposed under this article.

The violation of any provision of this article shall be a misdemeanor punishable by fine not to exceed \$500.00, or imprisonment for not more than 30 days, or both. Each day's violation of this article is a separate offense.

Criminal penalties . Any person who violates any section of this chapter is guilty of a class 3 misdemeanor as defined by state law at the time of the offense, unless otherwise provided by law.

Violation of this article is a misdemeanor punishable as provided in G.S. 14-4 plus a fine of \$500.00 per beaver brought in from outside of Currituck County for collection.

Any person found guilty by a court of competent jurisdiction of willfully violating the provisions of this chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be subject to a fine and/or imprisonment as provided in section 1-8.
EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT	https://library.municode.com/nc/currituck_county/codes/code_of_ordinances?nodeId=COOR_CH6EMMA_ARTIIE MMAAG	CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE II, EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY	This article is an exercise by the county of its governmental functions for the protection of the public peace, health, and safety, and neither the county nor its agents and representatives nor any individual, receiver, firm, partnership, corporation, association, or trustee or any of the agents thereof in good faith carrying out, complying with or attempting to comply with any order, rule or regulation promulgated pursuant to this article, shall be liable for any damage sustained to person or property as the result of such activity. It shall be a misdemeanor for any person to violate any of the provisions of this article or plans issued pursuant to the authority contained in this article, or to willfully obstruct, hinder or delay any member of the emergency management organization in the enforcement of the provisions of this article or any plan issued pursuant to this article.

Any person violating any prohibition or restriction imposed by a proclamation authorized by this article shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

CHAPTER 7, ARTICLE
III, FIRE PREVENTION
CODE

The fire prevention code shall be enforced by the bureau of fire prevention of the office of the fire marshal with the aid of the respective township fire departments of the county. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of the fire prevention code adopted in this article or fail to comply therewith, who shall violate or fail to comply with any order made thereunder, who shall build in violation of any detailed statement of specifications or plans submitted and approved thereunder or any certificate or permit issued thereunder and from which no appeal has been taken, or who shall fail to comply with such an order as affirmed or modified by the fire marshal or by a court of competent jurisdiction within the time fixed in such order, shall severally for each and every such violation and noncompliance, respectively, be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not more than \$50.00 or by imprisonment for not more than 30 days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

CHAPTER 8, ARTICLE
II, SEXUALLY
ORIENTED
BUSINESSES

It is the purpose of this article to regulate sexually oriented businesses to promote the health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of the County of Currituck, and to establish reasonable and uniform regulations to prevent the deleterious effects of sexually oriented businesses. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this article shall be guilty of a misdemeanor as provided in G.S. 14-4 and, upon conviction, shall be subject to the maximum fine of \$500.00, or imprisonment, or both. Each violation shall be considered a separate and distinct offense, and each day of continued violation shall be considered as a separate offense. The issuance of a notice of violation or a suspension or revocation of a sexually oriented business license shall not prohibit the imposition of a criminal penalty and the imposition of a criminal penalty shall not prevent the issuance of a notice of violation or a suspension or revocation of the license. In the event that G.S. 14-4 is amended as to the amount of fine or time of incarceration that may be imposed, the maximum penalties that may be imposed by court of competent jurisdiction under any such amendment are automatically applicable in lieu of those stated herein.

CHAPTER 8, ARTICLE
III, PAWNBROKERS

This article shall be known and may be cited as the pawnbrokers ordinance of Currituck County. Pursuant to G.S. 91A-11, every person, his guests, or employees who shall knowingly violate any of the provisions of this article shall on conviction be deemed guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor and shall be fined a sum not to exceed \$500.00 for each offense, and at the discretion of the court may be imprisoned for a period of time not to exceed 30 days. If the violation is by an owner or major stockholder or managing partner of the pawnshop and the violation is knowingly committed by the owner, major stockholder or managing partner of the pawnshop, the licenses of the pawnshop may be suspended at the discretion of the court.

Manufacture, sale and use of pyrotechnics prohibited. The violation of this article shall be a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punishable by a fine not more than \$500.00 or by imprisonment for not more than 30 days.

CHAPTER 13, ARTICLE
III, WATER
CONSERVATION AND
RESTRICTION PLAN

When any of the county's public water systems have a low and declining water supply due to drought or emergency conditions that will affect the availability of water for human consumption, sanitation, health and fire protection, it will be necessary to declare a water shortage followed by implementation of conservation requirements and water restrictions set forth under the guidelines below. Upon a fourth violation of this article, a criminal warrant shall be issued to the offending person(s). Any violations of the provisions of this article shall constitute a Class 3 misdemeanor punishable upon conviction by a fine not exceeding a maximum of \$500.00 as provided by G.S. 14-4 and in addition thereto such violation may be enjoined and restrained as provided in G.S. 160A-175. The issuing of a criminal warrant shall not prohibit the imposition of further civil penalties.
