As you know, SL 2019-198 requires municipalities with 1,000 or more residents to report to you those local ordinances that contain a criminal penalty. I understand from the League of Municipalities that you prefer to receive this report via email. Please let me know if you would like to receive this report in some other fashion.

The Town of Enfield's Code of Ordinances contain no criminal penalties for violations thereof. The Town only has authority to enforce civil penalties under its Code.
