Section 14.1 of the City's UDO makes it unlawful to erect, construct, alter, maintain, expand, move or use any structure or sign or engage in development or subdivision of land contrary to any

provision of this ordinance. Section 14.1 also states that whenever any provision of this ordinance requires the performance of an act or prohibits the performance of any act, or whenever

any regulation is imposed on the use of land and water, or on the erection of a structure, failure to comply with such provision is unlawful. Therefore, violation of the following sections of the UDO
