Solid Waste	Chapter 50A	Disposal of solid waste	
Abandoned and Junked Vehicles; Junk Removal	Chapter 90	Abandoned/junk/nuisance motor vehicles	Violators are guilty of a misdemeanor and be subject to a fine not to exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00) or thirty (30) days in jail
Animals	Chapter 91A	Care and handling of animals	Violators may be charged with a misdemeanor and be subject to a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or thirty (30) days in jail
Noise Control	Chapter 92A	Noise	Violators may be charged with a misdemeanor and be subject to a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or thirty (30) days in jail
Parks and Recreation	Chapter 93	Activities within park/recreation properties: public intoxication, bringing drugs or alcohol into park, building fires, entering closed park, etc Allowing situations that are dangerous or prejudicial to the public health or safety and to constitute a public nuisance; ie unsecured structures, accumulation of rubbish, uncontrolled growth of noxious weeds or grass, etc	Violators may be charged with a misdemeanor and be subject to a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or thirty (30) days in jail
Public Nuisances	Chapter 94		Violators may be criminally charged subject to provisions of NCGS 14-4

Graffiti Abatement	Chapter 94A	Graffiti vandalism	Violators may be charged with a misdemeanor and be subject to a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or thirty (30) days in jail
Streets and Sidewalks	Chapter 95	Deals with deposit of foreign materials on public streets, obstructing visibility at intersections and encroachments within the Town rights-of-way.	Violators may be charged with a misdemeanor and be subject to a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or thirty (30) days in jail
Advertising	Chapter 111	Attaching advertising to private property without owner consent	Violators may be charged with a misdemeanor and be subject to a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or thirty (30) days in jail
Charitable Solicitation Control	Chapter 112	solicitation without permit; interference with free passage of/access to sidewalks and ROWs to solicit or distribute materials	Violators may be charged with a misdemeanor and be subject to a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or thirty (30) days in jail
Taxicabs	Chapter 113	operating a taxicab without certificate of necessity, not in accordance with local and state laws, without payment of license fees, etc	Violators may be charged with a misdemeanor and be subject to a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or thirty (30) days in jail

Tax on Gross Receipts Derived from Short-Term Lease or Rental of Heavy Equipment	Chapter 117	Taxes relating to lease/rental of heavy equipment	Violators willfully evading payment are guilty of a Class H felony; violators failing to collect, withhold, account for or pay the tax are guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor; violators failing to pay tax, make returns, keep records or supply information are guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor
Peddlers, Solicitors and Itinerant Merchants	Chapter 118	Itinerant sales	Violators may be charged with a misdemeanor and be subject to a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or thirty (30) days in jail
Offenses Against Town Regulations	Chapter 130	Disorderly conduct; public intoxication; discharge of firearms; electric fences; begging/alms solicitation; public masturbation; carrying firearms within certain public facilities; posting of street addresses; public urination/defecation; camping, etc on public property; bonfires; noxious substances; obstruction devices; attachments to property	Violators may be charged with a misdemeanor and be subject to a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or thirty (30) days in jail Violators are guilty of a misdemeanor and be subject to a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or thirty (30) days in jail
Building Regulations	Chapter 150	Building/construction	Violators may be charged with a misdemeanor and be subject to a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or thirty (30) days in jail
Post Construction Storm Water Re; UDO 155.807		Storm water leaving a site after construction	Violators may be charged with a misdemeanor and be subject to a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or thirty (30) days in jail

Floodplain Regulations	UDO 155.205	Construction within a floodplain	Violators may be charged with a misdemeanor and be subject to a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or thirty (30) days in jail
Temporary Uses	UDO 155.214.D	Short term business uses	Violators may be charged with a misdemeanor and be subject to a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or thirty (30) days in jail
Final Plats	UDO 155.214.F.2	Subdivisions & sale or transfer of land	Violators may be charged with a misdemeanor and be subject to a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or thirty (30) days in jail
Communications Facilities	UDO 155.506.41.F.2.c	Regulations when working within rights of way	If the ordinance is violated, the Town, at its discretion, may charge a violator with a misdemeanor. Violations of the PCO may be enforced as a misdemeanor subject to the maximum fine permissible under NC law
Post Construction Storm Water Re	UDO 155.801-155.807	Storm water runoff	Violators may be criminally charged subject to provisions of NCGS 14-4
Mecklenburg County Code Enforce	UDO 155.1005	Building codes, inspections	
Floodplain Regulations	UDO 155.901-906	Floodplain regulations; prohibits uses that are dangerous to health, safety and general welfare due to flood conditions; controls alteration of natural flood waters; controls filling, grading, dredging, etc that may increase erosion or flood damage; requires vulnerbale uses to be prtected against flood damage at time of construction; regulates flood barriers	Violators may be charged with a misdemeanor and be subject to a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or thirty (30) days in jail
