Section 6-1011 to 6-1018	Failure to comply with solicitation regulations	
Section 6-2001-2029	Obstructing sidewalks and streets, littering, parades and demonstrations without a permit	
Section 7-1001 to 7-1165	Use of compression brakes within town limits, failure to obey police or fire department officials, failure to obey traffic-control devices, display of unauthorized traffic control devices	
Section 8-2001 to 8-2010	Allowing animals to run at large, not removing animal waste from any public property or right-of-way, or private property (without permission), cruelty to animals, not maintaining fowl in accordance with regulations.	
Section 8-3001 to 8-3011	Abandoned and junk motor vehicles	
Section 8-4001 to 8-4008	Public nuisances-noxious weeds, high grass, accumulation of trash; noise violations; discharge of firearms in town limits; discharge of fireworks in town limits	
Sex Offenders in Public Parks Ordinance	Registered sex offenders in public parks	
Minimum Housing Ordinance	Failure to abide by minimum housing regulations	
Open Burning Ordinance	Open burning within the town limits	
Unified Development Ordinance	Failure to abide by the zoning and subdivision regulations in the Unified Development Ordinance
