30.33	Prevents Board members from modifying, abridging, changing or annulling any ordinance outside of a regular meeting
32.29	Unlawful for any person to resist, assault, ridicule, oppose or threaten a law enforcement officer in discharging their duties.
34.01	Unlawful for any person to violate any provision or restriction during a state of emergency
34.39	Unlawful for any person to violate any provision established by the Cherokee County Civil Preparedness Agency
50.02	Prevents any person, firm or corporation to make water connections without an authorized permit
50.03	Separate water connections are required for each individual business or residential building. Requires any person, firm or corporation to hook up to town water and sewer if a line is within 200, 300 feet, with certain exceptions.

50.05	Prevents any person from taking water away from public fountain or other public place Requires all businesses and residential buildings to have separate connections if their building has separate power meters

50.07	Prevents any person from cut off the Town's supply of water
50.08	Tampering with or obstructing water lines
50.09	Only authorized employees and approved plumbers can construct new connections

51.02	Prevents any person from disposing of unsanitary waste upon public or private property within the town.
51.03	discharging waste into water without proper treatment
51.04	unlawful to construct or maintain privy and certain other facilities
51.05	public sewers required for all property owners that have a public sewer line within 200 feet
51.06	requires all private septic tanks to have a permit before construction
51.07	tampering with public sewer or appurtenances prohibited
51.10	independent sewer for each building with certain exceptions
51.11	use of old building sewers

51.13	proper connections of building sewer into public sewer line

51.15	safety for excavations for building sewer requirements illegal to discharge storm water, surface water, ground water, roof runoff, subsurface drainage, cooling water or unpolluted

- 90.043 construction near sidewalk requires an overhead passage so the sidewalk remains unobstructed and safe
- 90.044 Illegal to erect anything over a sidewalk or street any part of a building except marquees and signs without approval of building inspector
- 90.045 roller skating and skateboards are prohibited except on sidewalks in residential zoning districts
- 90.046 riding bicycles on sidewalks illegal except in residential zoning districts
- 90.060 littering on town streets, sidewalks or alleyways regulated
- 90.061 littering from vehicles regulated

- 90.063 suitable receptacles must be provided in all parking or access areas described in 90.062

- 96.07 profane, boisterous or insulting language prohibited in town recreation areas and parks
- 96.08 alcohol and narcotic drugs prohibited in town parks and recreation areas
- 96.09 dumping in town parks and recreation areas prohibited
- 96.10 unlawful to make or kindle a fire in any park, except in a regularly constructed fireplace or grill
- 96.11 digging in any park illegal unless permit is granted by foreman or clerk
- 96.12 games and sports must be played in designated areas of town parks
- 96.13 destroying plants in town parks prohibited
- 96.14 animals cannot run at large in town parks or recreation areas
- 96.15 illegal to trap, catch, wound or kill any bird or animal in any park or recreation area
- 97.01 owners of any lot or other land in town cannot allow grass, weeds or other vegetation to grow taller than 12"
