Animals and Fowl	Chapter 4; Section 4-6	Violation of the Town's ordinances and regulations on animals and fowl.	Class 3- G.S. 14-4(a)
Dangerous Animals; Public Nuisance	Section 4-8	Town or County Animal Control Officer has declared an animal dangerous.	Class 1- G.S. 14-4(a), fine up to \$500
Animal Bite Cases	Section 4-19.c	Failure to confine animal after animal has bit a person.	Class 2- G.S. 14-4(a)
Permit Required	Section 5-25	Violations of the NC Building Code.	G.S. 14-4(a)
Fire Prevention Inspections and Enforcement	Chapter 5, Article IV	Violation of the Town's ordinances and regulations on fire prevention inspections.	G.S. 14-4(a), each day is a separate offense
Failure to Comply with Order	Section 5-67.c	Failure to comply with an order to repair, alter or improve or to vacate and close an unsafe nonresidential structure.	Class 3- G.S. 14-4(a)
In Rem Action by Inspector; Placarding.	Section 5-125.a	Occupation of building unfit for human habitation.	G.S. 14-4(a)
Health and Sanitation	Chapter 6	Violation of County Health Regulations.	G.S. 14-4(a)
Operation of Vehicles on the Public Streets	Chapter 7, Article II	Violation of the Town's ordinances and regulations of operating vehicles on public streets.	G.S. 14-4(a)

Pedestrian Rights and Duties	Chapter 7, Article III	Violation of the Town's ordinances and regulations on pedestrian rights and duties.	G.S. 14-4(a)
Cruising	Chapter 7, Article V	Violation of the Town's ordinances and regulations on cruising.	Class 3- G.S. 14-4(a), fine up to \$50
Begging and Soliciting	Chapter 9, Article 2	Soliciting without a valid permit or without taking part in a festival.	G.S. 14-4(a), fine up to \$100
Weapons Prohibited	Section 9-51.c	Violation of the Town's ordinances and regulations of weapons on municipal owned property.	G.S. 14-4(a), fine up to \$500
Indecent exposure; Obscene Shows, etc.	Section 9-77	Violation of the Town's ordinances and regulations on indecent exposure.	G.S. 14-4(a)
Disruptive Behavior in Public	Section 9-82	Violation of the Town's ordinances and regulations on disruptive behavior.	G.S. 14-4(a), fine up to \$50
Loitering	Section 9-103	A person remaining or wandering about in a public place under circumstances manifesting the intent to engage in a violation of the North Carolina Controlled Substances Act.	G.S. 14-4(a), fine up to \$50 for every offense
Sexually Explicit Materials, Display to Minors	Chapter 9, Article XI	Violation of the Town's ordinances and regulations of sexual explicit materials displayed where they can be observed by minors.	G.S. 14-4(a)

Curfews for Minors	Chapter 9, Article XII	Violation of the Town's ordinances and regulations on curfews for minors.	G.S. 14-4(a), fine up to \$100
Civil Emergencies	Chapter 12, Article IV	Violations of an State of Emergency Decree.	G.S. 14-4(a), fine up to \$50
Public Works	Chapter 13	Violation of the Town's ordinances and regulations on matters involving Public Works.	Class 3- G.S. 14-4(a), fine up to \$50, each day a separate offense
Excavation and Repair	Chapter 14, Article II	Violation of the Town's ordinances and regulations on excavation and repair.	Class 3- G.S. 14-4(a), fine up to \$500
Registration Required	Section 15-31	Failure to register business with the Town.	G.S. 14-4(a), fine up to \$500
