Code 1974-11/2	Willfully fail or refuse to comply with any lawful order
Sec. 24-7	Person(s) riding bicycles (etc.) not to cling to moving vehicles. Person(s) cannot Attach himself or herself to any moving conveyance or vehicle upon the roadway.
Sec. 24-99 1974-11/43	PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES When signs are placed, erected or when the curbing has been painted yellow in lieu of signs.
Sec. 24-100 1974-11/4	Parking prohibited for specified purposes (1.) Displaying vehicle for sale (2.) Washing, greasing or repairing such vehicle except repairs necessitated by an emergency (3.) Storage thereof by garages, dealers or other person(s) when such storage is not incidental to bona fide use and operation of such automobile or other vehicle (4.) Storage of any detached trailer or van
Sec. 24-101 1974-11/45	ADVERTISING No person shall stand or park on any vehicle on any street for the primary purpose of advertising.
Sec. 24-102 1974-11/46	Parking prohibited during certain hours in certain designated places.
Sec. 16-1 7-11-91 Reference: GS-18B-1	GENERALLY WHEN SIGNS ARE PLACED CONSUMPTION OF INTOXICATING LIQUORS IN PUBLIC PLACES It shall be unlawful to consume intoxicating liquors (beer, fortified or unfortified wine or liquor) in any public building, lots, parks, grounds, streets, sidewalks, driveways or other premises owned or leased by the town. Except: (1) R E Hooks Community Building (2) Civic Center

Sec. 16-3	OBSTRUCTION OF (EXITS) IN PLACES OF PUBLIC ASSEMBLAGE
	(A) All doors, aisles and passageways within or without theaters, churches that might obstruct or delay the exit.
	(B) Clear passage
	(C) No passageway or stairway in any store or be obstructed
Sec. 16-6 1974/13-7	Discharging firearms, explosives in Town
	Cannot discharge any firearms or explosives in Town
Sec. 16-9	Carrying concealed weapons on Town Property
Sec. 16-16	Begging
	Cannot beg on public right of way, road shoulders, ditches, sidewalks, privately owned property without first obtaining written permission.
Sec. 12-27	Noises: Expressly Prohibited
	(1) The sounding of any horn or signal device on any automobile, motorcycle, bus or any other vehicle while not in motion, except as a danger signal.
	(2) Siren upon any vehicle except fire, police, or other emergency vehicle
	(3) Animals or birds which cause frequent noise.
Sec. 4-27 6-12 1975	Dog running at large prohibited
	It shall be unlawful for any dog to run at large in the town.
