- 6. Junk Yards. Location and conditions for junk yards
- 7. Zoning Ordinance. Land Use requirements for town and extra territorial jurisdiction
- 8. Subdivision Regulations. Division of Land into smaller parcels
- 9. Trailers and Trailer Parks. Location and maintenance of manufactured homes.
- 10. Animals. Containment and conditions of keeping animals
- 11. Littering. Littering
- 12. Public Nuisances on Private Property. Undesirable activities on private property
- 13. Discharge of Firearms. Discharge of Firearms
- 14. Disturbing Public Meetings. Disrupting public meetings.
