These individuals are also authorized to and may remove, or cause to be removed, from the Town any person in violation of the provisions of this ordinance. Each and every instance of a violation of this ordinance shall be as a minimum, a misdemeanor.

Any person who shall willfully make any false statement in an application for license under any section of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
