IMPACT OF CEP FOR BLADEN COUNTY SCHOOLS

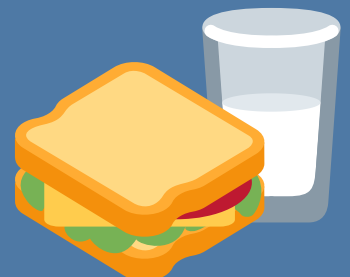
The department earned an extra \$215.42 per student.
