Percentage of dropouts n = (23,034) grades 1-12

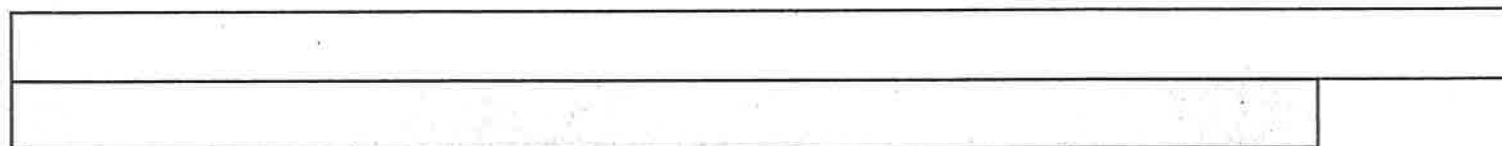

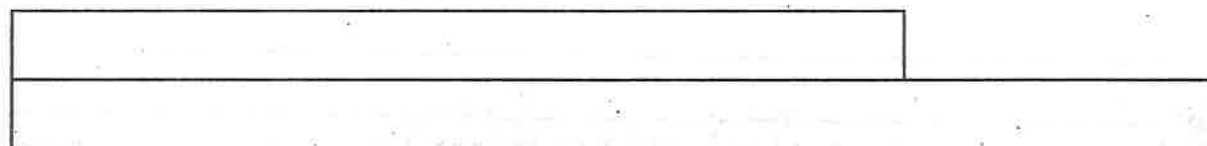

North Carolina School Membership and Dropouts by Race and Gender, 2000-01*

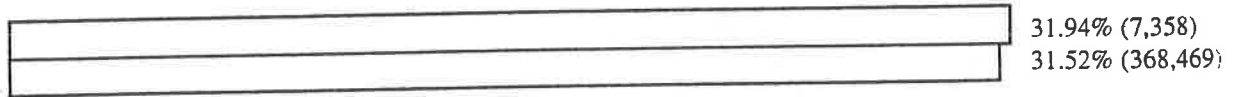

2000-01 Dropouts Grade Levels 1-12

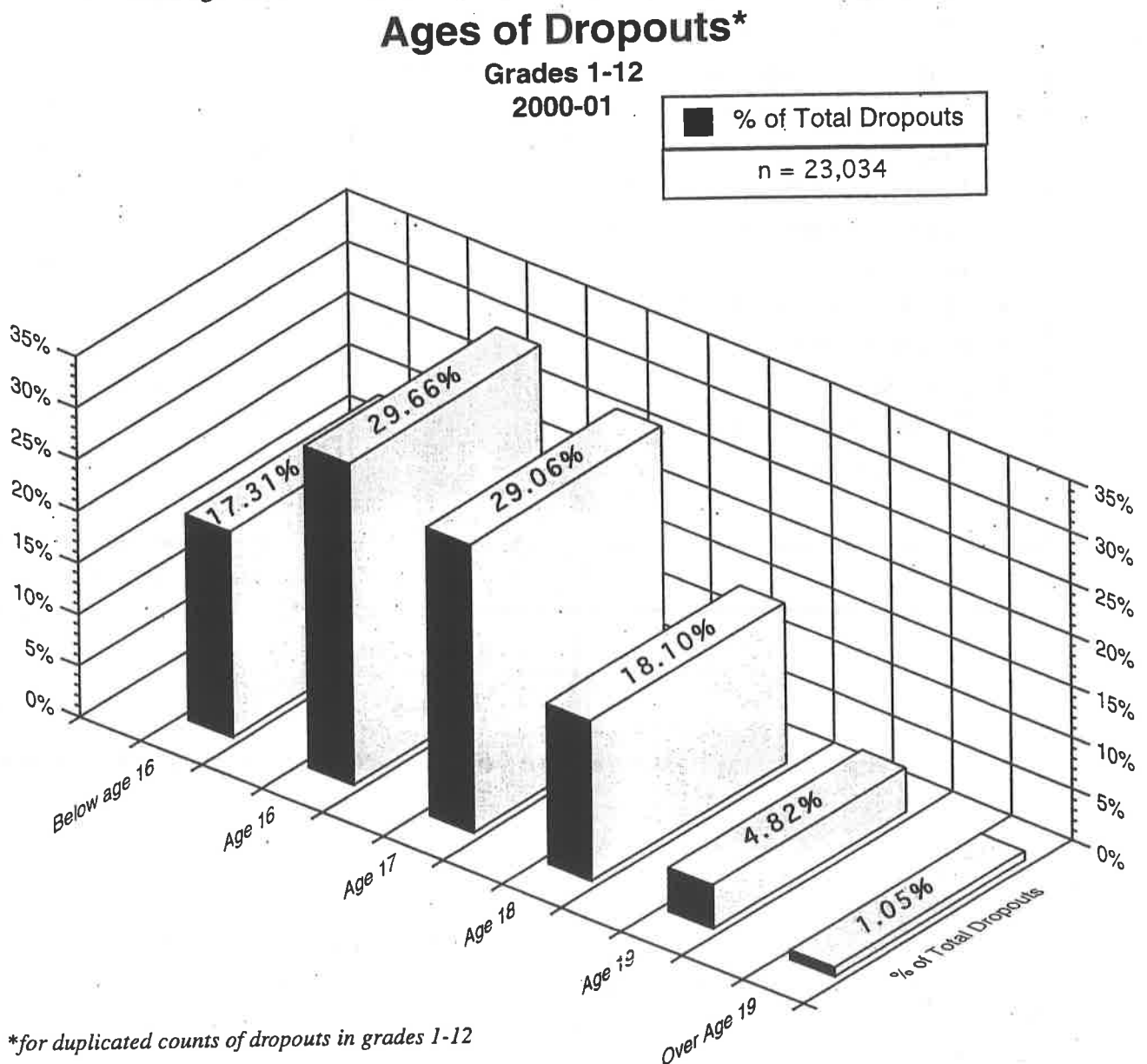
